The BOOK of DISCIPLINE 2004, OF THE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH

¶ 264.5 Peace with Justice Sunday... has been celebrated with an offering on the First Sunday After Pentecost. Congregations are to observe Peace with Justice Sunday on this date or on another date appropriate to the local church....

¶ 264.5a) The annual conference treasurer shall retain 50 percent of the receipts for Peace with Justice ministries in the annual conference, to be administered by the annual conference board of church and society or equivalent structure.

The typical grant is \$500.00 to \$1,500.00. Funds are not be used for salaries.

Funding requests shall be considered for programs/projects of the following agencies or organizations, with preference given in the following order:

1. Projects/programs of the Conference Board of Church and Society that enhance the goals of the Peace with Justice Program (**The BOOK of RESOLUTIONS 2004, pages 826 - 830**), or that further the work of the Board of Church and Society on other advocacy and justice issues.
2. Projects/programs of Local Churches of the Annual Conference that address peace, justice, and environmental justice issues – may be through education, advocacy, political action, biblical witness etc. New projects/programs will be given priority.
3. Ecumenical based organizations or agencies that seek funding for programs or projects that do one or more of the following:
 - a) Enhance the ministry of the Board of Church and Society;
 - b) Invite and encourage public advocacy for peace with justice issues;

New projects/programs will be given priority.

Incomplete applications will be returned.
