

PEACE WITH JUSTICE GRANTS APPLICATION
Conference Board of Church and Society
Wisconsin Annual Conference - United Methodist Church

Typical Grant: \$500.00 to \$2,000.00.

Restrictions: Funds are not to be used for salaries.

Eligibility: Any Local Church or Ecumenical group within the geographical area of the Wisconsin Conference of the United Methodist Church and that works for peace, reconciliation, justice or creation care is potentially eligible.

- Preference will be given first to groups within or related to the United Methodist Church then to others that enhance our ministries.
- Priority will be given to those projects that include advocacy to influence decision makers and/or empowerment of people to help themselves.
- First-time requests will be considered before repeat requests.
- Incomplete applications will be returned.

Project goals: Project goals must focus on peacebuilding, reduction of violence, reconciliation, reduction of poverty, global health, and/or care of God's creation. Plans must include at least one of the following objectives.

1. Transform conflicts and reduce violence.
2. Restore communities suffering from the effects of violence and/or injustice.
3. Promote policies and attitudes that have the capacity to overcome disproportionate effects of injustices on racial and ethnic persons.
4. Reduce poverty by promoting just systems and the self-development of people.
5. Promote creation care.

Application deadlines: December 31 of current year for funding in following year.
Applications may be received until 1/15/2010 for funding in 2010.
