As we approach our October meetings I want to suggest some ideas for the meetings in your areas. Listed below are some basic formats. The first meeting of Pastors and Lay Leaders should be part of every stop.

Type meeting	Description	Time	Focus of meeting
Meet with Pastor(s) and Lay Leaders to discuss Men's Ministry plans.	Plan your ministry	1 hour to "As long as you want."	Help a leadership team focus, start and or just listen.
Part of a church service	Delivering message or service.	20-30 minutes	Challenge men to address their calling from God. Connect with the UMM.
Conducting a men's church service	1 hr or length of your service	1-? Hours	Challenge men to address their calling from God. Connect with the UMM.
Meeting with or without, breakfast/lunch/dinner	Conducting a meeting. Include more than one speaker and/or theme	1-3 hours	Challenge men to address their calling from God. Connect with the UMM.
Organizational Meeting	Organize and connect with others and the UMM.	1-3 hours	Challenge men to address their calling from God. Connect with the UMM.
Training	Formal training session	2-7 hours	Training in ways to bring men to Christ. Intentional Discipleship. Leader Training

Make disciples for Jesus Christ. Increase awareness of God's call. Find processes and structures that create places for men to grow. Invite men. Equip men. Send men out.
