REFLECTION ON 2010 AND GOALS FOR 2011**

Vision Team: a dedicated group of lay and clergy from across the metro north and south region who want to assist local churches through visionary conversation, connection, resourcing and training.

Reflecting on 2010 goals:

We will continue to facilitate the conversation between the innermost city churches' laity and clergy around the topic of an urban strategy.

This conversation has found support this year from Circuits in our near city areas who want more information and/or are already engaged in their own conversations on creative sharing and collaboration for programming and for survival.

We will polish and package the media based Lay Leaders Training Resource for Conference wide distribution with multi-lingual options.

This has been accomplished in Spanish and is in process for Hmong and Korean congregational leadership. The training has been used in other regions with good feedback.

We will plan relevant training and programming using the resource feedback sheets remitted at the 2010 District Conference.

We conveyed to the Conference a request for Finance training and tabled ideas in environmental stewardship en lieu of the national RETHINK team's willingness to offer training in our area in 2011. Names of individuals listing themselves as willing to work with the vision team have been retained for as needed contacts with our thanks.

We will utilize the Conference Board of Lay Ministry as a resource to us in the planning for continuing support for local church lay leaders.

This has remained conversational only.

We will continue to pursue a resource data base utilizing the Circuit Clergy leadership to gather information and the District webmaster for help with web-based distribution of the collated information.

We did not get the hoped-for web coordination assistance requested so this project has been tabled.

We will offer one (1) annual Metro Districts gathering for the purpose of celebration, information sharing and fellowship across the region.

RETHINK CHURCH event/District Conference 2.18-19.11 is it!

As we Vision for 2011:

We will continue to facilitate urban strategy conversation through the Circuit table and with other groups by request.

We will continue to strive for relevant training and event offerings that enhance our connection, provide greater impact on the needs of our communities and inspire more hearts to see God's goodness.

We will offer one (1) Metro Districts gathering for the purpose of celebration, information sharing and fellowship across the region.

We will continue to invite and welcome our District Leadership, both lay and clergy, to the Vision Team table for conversation and collaboration.

We will assess tabled projects and act on them as mutually discerned.

Policy Statement on Metros District Grants

The Metros District makes occasional small grants by request for ministry and mission development to congregations in the Metros Region. Funding for this is possible through payment of the *District Asking*, which is 60 cents per member in 2010. The District Superintendent has authorized the Vision Team to provide consultation on all funding proposals. Requests are evaluated by individual merit according to the quality of information provided describing the project and defining the need. All funding proposals are considered in the form in which they are presented rather than forced into compliance with a uniform format or a predetermined evaluation rubric. Funding requests with supporting documents should be sent to the Metros Districts Office. The next meeting of the Vision Team is March 10, 2011.

To all District Conference attendees:

The Metro Districts Region is blessed by the faithful giving of District Asking/Apportionment that provides local congregations in the Metro North and South Districts ready access to funds for training, materials, special projects, group event support and resources that would otherwise go unfunded and untried.

We will again vote to set a rate of asking per local church member at our District Conference on Saturday, February 19k, 2011 to be communicated then via electronic letter from the Vision Team and the District Office to each church.

We've heard from some the frustration and uncertainty about whether or not these annual payments are being made due in part to the fact that the numbers are not being communicated clearly for each church.

We've heard your voices, especially when you were all trying to take advantage of the great price break for the RETHINK event and so we're responding.

Please expect a "Statement of District Support" to come to each of your churches by April 1, 2011.

Please be sure that this information gets to the pastor and to the Church Treasurer for action. We would suggest this letter along with an explanation of what these funds provide be shared at the Administrative Council table for affirmation and communication as you plan ministry together.

This is just one way that we 'vision' being connectional in our region!

Minutes of the Meeting

We were welcomed by Rev. Kelly Fowler, chairperson of the Metro District Vision Team, who thanked Tom Leih, Sue Leih, Barb Ridgely, and Don Greer for all of the “Gnomenclatures,” hard work, time, and effort that was put into organizing and planning today's event.

We reviewed the correct answers for our Metro – Gnome game – seeing how many churches around the District people could identify from the pictures taken of Metro – our Gnome who has taken time to roam around the Metro District. (Thanks to Tom, Becky, and Sue Leih – especially Tom – for all the time and energy – you made it a fun start!). The winners of the awarded prizes (small items from the Holy Land) were Gail Burgess and Betty McManus. Congratulations and job well done!

Our worship began as we sang, prayed, and heard scripture proclaimed. We had 2 speakers for the worship service today – giving testimony to some “Hope filled Gnoments.”

Kelly introduced the first speaker – Geovanny Leiva from Luz a las Naciones who gave an inspiring personal testimony about how he has learned that God is in control. Geovanny, a youth member of the church was filled with the Holy Spirit and blessed us all with his message.

Next, Rev. Don Greer (serving at Summerfield UMC), read scripture and witnessed to his experience of the beginning of a collective journey. Don shared with us that there are struggling congregations – especially in the inner city of Milwaukee and so the District Vision Team was beginning to look at the possibilities and feasibility of an Urban Strategy. The idea was actually birthed at a consultation, so we could find out what is working now around the States. There is no current working model for this; so a small team went to 3 City Circuits with an appeal to have conversations about Urban Strategy at their individual churches as well as within the Circuit. One of the tools that could be used in the evaluation process of the viability of the congregations is Paragraph 213 of the Book of Discipline. This can be used as a self study. 2 more meetings were held with a good response. This process has an open door and open table for anyone(s) interested to be a part of the journey and discussion. If interested – please join in. It is a grass roots effort.

This led into our District Conference Business (a part of our worship service).

Mark Sheets, the Metro North District Lay Leader and Deanna Shimko, the Metro South District Lay Leader presided over the Business meeting.

The first order of business was the official election of the secretary. Since the nominations slate offered the name of Sue Leih as our Districts Vision Team secretary, she was nominated to serve as the official secretary for this meeting by Kelly Fowler. This was seconded by Barb Ridgely and was approved unanimously.

The offering being taken today was for the UMCOR Advanced Special to help our brothers and sisters in Haiti. The offering was taken while special music was played. The offerings were blessed by all present. Monetary offering going to UMCOR was \$295.98

Rev. Jorge then presented a message about cultivating generosity based on Matthew 6: 19-21. He reminded all of us that cultivating the spirit of generosity blesses everyone and that we can give in service, give with a good attitude, and give of self. That giving wholeheartedly isn't just about money.

Kelly summed up the journey's shared today to conclude the Conference.

We were then given a short announcement/encouragement about being advocates for the ministries at Northcott Neighborhood house. A letter went out to all District churches asking for liaison names. Very poor response – so we were encouraged to follow up and participate with Northcott.

Rev. Jorge gave us the final blessing and we were all invited to participate in a fellowship time with wonderful refreshments and time for conversation and time to review the special Gnome words and meanings.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:15pm
