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Transportation to and from Camp

Both pick-up and drop-off times will be approximately around noon on Sunday and Friday, however times will be confirmed when we receive your camp registration.

What to Bring

Clothes

- › Shorts & long pants for evenings

- › Bathing suits (one-piece preferred for girls)
- › Water shoes or flip flops
- › Tennis shoes and socks (bring extra pairs of socks)
- › Sweatshirt or jacket for evenings

Toiletries

- › Toothpaste & toothbrush
- › Hair brush
- › Sun screen
- › Bug spray
- › Shower supplies (shampoo, soap)
- › Deodorant (if needed)

Other Supplies

- › Sleeping bag & pillow (or sheets, blanket, & pillow)
- › Towel for swimming & for the shower
- › Flashlight
- › Refillable water bottle
- › Copy of insurance card

Please do not bring: electronics, items of value, weapons, drugs, tobacco or alcohol, expensive clothing, or any item that a child would be upset if lost.
